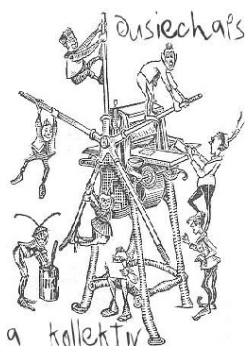

and small white

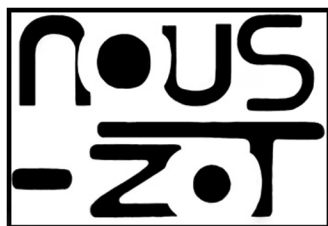
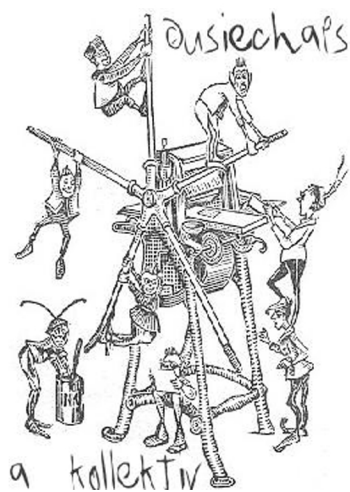
